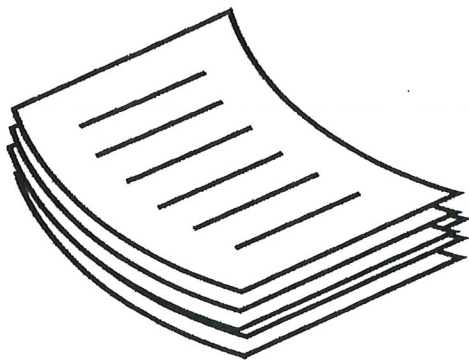

PROVIDE DISABILITY DOCUMENTATION
