1. Complete the International Student Information Form.

- Submit proof of English proficiency. We accept the following English proficiency tests. <u>TOEFL</u>: A score of 70 or better in Internet based Test (iBT) <u>IELTS Academic</u>: An overall Band Score of 6 or better <u>Duolingo</u>: A score of 100 or higher <u>LanguageCert Academic</u>: A score of 75 or higher <u>Please submit an official score sheet to show the valid test scores.</u>
- 3. Submit copies of secondary school records (transcripts) AND certificate or diploma, along with a certified English translation attached to the original copies, if they are not in English. Graduation from secondary school comparable to an American high school diploma is required. This is education completion required before admission to a university. School records (or transcripts) include graduation date, courses completed, completion dates and value earned for each course.
- 4. Submit an Evidence of Financial Support form and a bank letter. A letter from the bank must show that the sponsor or the student (if self-funded) has sufficient funds on deposit. The bank letter must:
 - Be on official letterhead paper/paper/stationery.
 - All documents should be submitted in English.
 - Include the sponsor's name, contact information, type of account and an available funds of equivalent to \$30,219 US dollars or more.
 - Be issued within six (6) months prior to the start of the semester.

Please note the American Embassy or Consulate may require original financial documents at the visa interview. *Changes in tuition and fees may be made without notice.

- 5. Copy of transcripts from all colleges and/or universities (if applicable) For credit transfers, official transcripts must be mailed directly from the college/university attended directly to CGCC International Education Program. For transcripts from college/university outside of the U.S., please complete the <u>credential evaluation process</u>, then have an evaluation report sent to CGCC International Education Program.
- 6. A photocopy of **your identification page** in your passport.

Additional requirements if you are applying from within the United States as transfer student or applying for change of status to F-1 only:

- 7. A copy of the I-94 electronic record
- 8. A copy of the Visa page/stamp in your passport.
- 9. A copy of ALL prior I-20s (only for those students applying as transfer student).
- 10. A complete <u>transfer eligibility form</u> (For a transfer student only).

Application Deadlines

To be guaranteed consideration for admission, ALL application materials must be received by:

- Fall Semester (August December) by July 1
- Spring Semester (January May) by November 1

Students Under 18 Years Old

CGCC recommends that students who are under the age of 18 (minors) have a guardian in the United States. In the event of personal emergency, accident, illness, incarceration, etc., the State of Arizona will require the signature of a guardian before assistance such as hospitalization, legal counsel, etc., can be offered. Chandler-Gilbert Community College is not permitted to act in the place of the parent or guardian.
